



When our state government permits large public gatherings, which of the following would you prefer for our church?



When our state government allows large group meetings and worship, which best describes your attitude toward returning to worship services in the church building? Select one:




In addition to our state government allowing large gatherings of people, are there other circumstances you would want to see before you return to worship? Select all that apply:

What precautions, if none are required by our state government, do you plan to take when you return to worship services? Select all that apply:






- 51.9% Limit handouts of any kind
- 67.1% Use a new method for Communion
- 63.2% Use new method for collecting tithes and offerings
- 63.6% Social distancing in Worship Services
- 52.4% Social distancing in Sunday School, Life Groups, Small Groups
- 68% Prop doors open so people don't have to touch handles
- 79.7% Provide hand sanitizer stations
- 48.9% Require masks for everyone
- 40.7% Provide masks for those not bringing their own
- 82.3% Discourage shaking hands
- 37.3% Allow a longer period of time between worship services
- 22.5% Eliminate singing in worship
- 5.6% None of these

Which of the following describes the attendance level at which you would be comfortable attending worship services? I would be comfortable attending if the Worship space is...




Would you be willing to attend worship services at a different time than you typically attend to allow people to be more spread out in the Worship Center?


Hospitality around worship services allows CUMC to connect with each other and welcome guests. When worship resumes in person, I would be comfortable with... Select all that apply

- 20.6% All food that is provided be individually packaged


Would you be willing to attend your Sunday School Class or Life group where it typically meets for groups of under 25?

14% Food or drinks provided individually packaged




Would you like to see the online worship experience continue to be available once regular services are being offered again?
