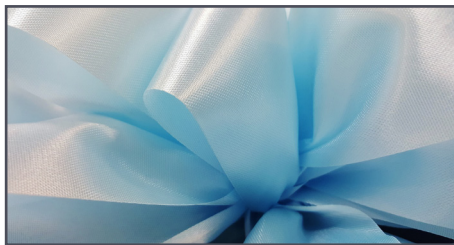
ANGEL TREE
