

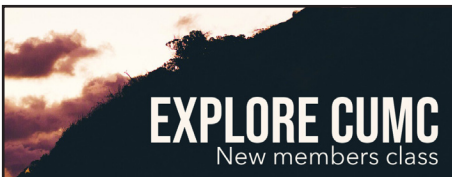

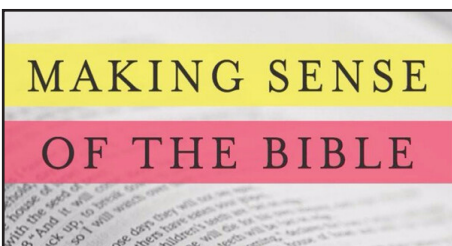
EXPLORE CUMC - NEW MEMBERS CLASS
