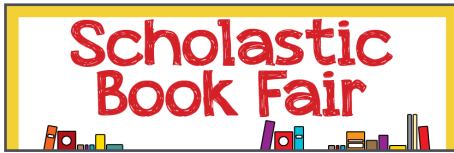

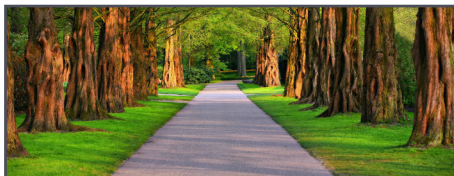
## SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR
